#### Save the Date: Bernal Heights Summer Solstice Stroll & Art Walk, Thursday, 6/20

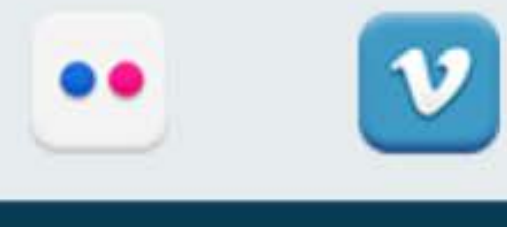
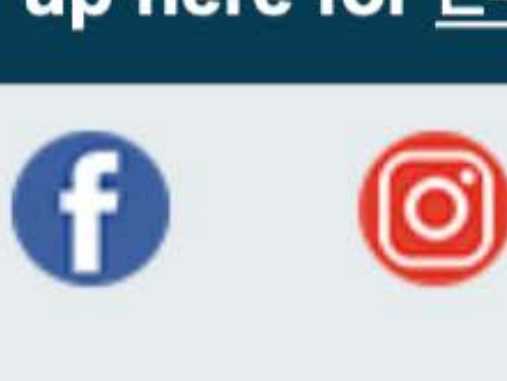
