





\$30,000

For the newly permitted street closure of our 18th Street merchant corridor. The closure will not only benefit the restaurants and merchants on the corridor; we will invite other businesses, arts groups and non-profits to use the street space to provide benefits to the greater community with performances, information booths and music.

STREET CLOSURE/ SUPPORT FOR NON-PROFIT ARTS GROUPS

\$15,000

To help support our non-profit arts groups. Arts groups have been especially hard hit by the pandemic and still have no timeline for re-opening. Several of them are active members of PDMA and we see their continuing existence as vital to the well-being of our community.
